Tyee Book Club


The Tyee Book Club has adjusted the meeting schedule to every other month: same time (7pm) & same day (Thursday). See the event calendar on the website for Zoom links.



The next meeting is **Thursday, March 23**, at 7pm to discuss the book *Two Years Before the Mast*, a memoir by the American author Richard Henry

Dana Jr., published in 1840, written after a two-year sea voyage from Boston to California on a merchant ship starting in 1834.

We will meet again on **Thursday, May 25**, at 7pm to discuss *Ship of Gold in the Deep Blue Sea* by Gary Kinder. This book is written by a friend of Alan Scott's. It is the true story of the recovery operation from the SS Central America and all of its treasure. *Ship of Gold in the Deep Blue Sea* tells the story of the sinking of the SS Central America, a side-wheel steamer carrying nearly six hundred passengers returning from the California Gold Rush, two hundred miles off the Carolina coast in September 1857. Over four hundred lives and twenty-one tons of California gold were lost. It was the worst peacetime disaster at sea in American history, a tragedy that remained lost in legend for over a century. We will be inviting the author to attend our meeting. We hope many Tyee members can come and enjoy this interesting experience.






